## Building Inspector Summary Report July 2012

- 1. Performed inspections at:
  - a. Jenkins Framing, insulation
  - b. Witte Site inspection with landscape designer regarding change in landscaping plans. Also reviewed project with general contractor noting remaining open items.
  - c. Hanson Tower Hill Rd. Issued letter regarding work to shed that requires BAR approval. Also notified Hanson of Building Permit expiration dates (Pool 8/16/12 & Walls/Patio Area 10/7/12).
  - d. Tuxedo Club fireworks display setup (Legion Fireworks Co.).
- 2. Contacted Mrs. Martin regarding piles of tree limbs that were placed on the neighboring property (Lindsay), and stacks of fire wood visible from the road and neighboring properties.
- 3. Contacted Mrs. Cathcart regarding removal of tree stumps along Tuxedo Rd. Have been advised that the stumps are scheduled to be ground up by the end of July.
- 4. Advised Mrs. Booth of a large tree on her property that appears to have been hit by lightening. Mrs. Booth has asked landscaping company to inspect the tree.
- 5. Advised Tuxedo Club Boatmaster, Eric Cathcart, that the flag pole at the Tuxedo Lake shoreline can be replaced without a permit.
- 6. Advised new owners of Dawson property located on West Lake Rd. of firewood storage regulations.
- 7. Contacted Verizon regarding transferring wires to new utility poles and removal of old utility poles. Also, relocating guy wires from dead trees on West Lake Rd.
- 8. Provided O&R with light bulbs for street lights.
- 9. Sent letter to Hatsis, West Lake Dr., regarding condition of property (letter attached). No response from property owner. Also contacted mortgage company earlier in the year and was advised that they have been advised not to perform any work on the property. Would like to recommend that the Village Board authorize the Village DPW to remove any limbs on the property and mow the lawn. The property owner will then be billed for the cleanup.
- 10. Similar to above, I have attempted to contact Isaac Levinbrown regarding the condition of 3 Acoma Rd. (letter attached) I ask that the Village Board consider authorizing the Village DPW to pick up any limbs and mow the lawn.

- 11. Sent letter to Mr. King, Clubhouse Rd., regarding cutting grass. Grass was cut within one week of notification.
- 12. Assisted with the removal of the flotation markers in Tuxedo Lake after Milfoil was removed by Aquatic Invasive Management.
- 13. Advised phone company of inoperative service between Water Plant and Ridge Road Water Tanks. Will request refund for time service was not being provided.
- 14. Issued Certificate of Occupancy to Klimecki house at 3 Ridge Rd.
- 15. Oversaw completion of repairs to the South Gate House that included carpet install, final painting touchup, garbage removal, new entrance steps, and new entrance door locks.
- 16. Attended meeting on July 24<sup>th</sup> with both VTP and Overton Subdivision engineers and attorneys to discuss water distribution system plans.

According to your site plan on file, dated March 29, 2010 with a revision date of February 28, 2011, a new foundation is proposed under the existing shed. The plans do not call for an increase in the shed height and the creation of a storage area underneath the shed.

If you wish to increase the height of the shed, please provide architectural plans, and a new building permit that clearly identifies the work that you are proposing. The plans must include existing and proposed elevations. The next meeting of the Board of Architectural Review is tentatively scheduled for August 7, 2012 at 7 p.m. The deadline date for submittal of the required paperwork and payment of all fees is July 27, 2012 at 4 p.m.

On a separate matter, by way of this letter, I am asking that the Board of Architectural Review confirm that the stone wall that you have started to construct along Tower Hill Road agrees with what they approved.
