Dear Neighbors,

I have really enjoyed being involved once again in the Village government serving you for the last two years. After much thought and discussion with my family, I have decided to run for an additional term in order to accomplish two primary goals. The first is to continue the gradual improvement of our infrastructure as well as the outdated sections of our Village Code. The second is to complete the work on re-building the Wee Wah Dam and return the lake to its natural beauty and level. This is the largest single public works project the Village has undertaken in over a decade, and I would like to see it brought in on time {spring 2015} and on budget {\$800,000}.

In order to help you make an informed voting decision, allow me to briefly review my public service record to the Village community. After moving to Tuxedo Park with my family in December of 1996, I joined the Tuxedo Park Fire Department in 1998. I served as its President from 1998 to 2001 and have served as its Treasurer from 2001 to the present. From 1999 to 2005, I was elected to serve three terms as a Village Trustee, and was appointed Deputy Mayor for the last five of those years. I was then re-elected as a Trustee in June of 2011 and asked by Mayor Wilson to be the Deputy Mayor once again.

During these four terms, I have been asked to take responsibility for many interesting and challenging responsibilities to include being the Village Budget Officer for six years and liaison to: the BAR for four years before it was divided into two entities; the Zoning Board of Appeals for two years; the Police Department for two years; the Wee Wah Beach, Boat, and Fishing Clubs; and the Village Court for eight years. In carrying out each of these responsibilities, I have had the opportunity to work with a broad cross section of both Village and Town residents and employees, which I have found to be the most rewarding aspect of serving our community.

I would like to close by telling you I am supporting Lili Neuhauser for Mayor and Susan Goodfellow for Trustee. I have had the pleasure of working with Lili for the last two years, and have an enormous respect for her work ethic, her dedication, and her unique ability to find a common ground in resolving the few issues we have differed on. Susan's resume of public service to the Village exceeds mine and her knowledge of the Village lakes is second to no one's. I have absolutely no doubt she will be a superb Trustee.
