Voters will be asked to decide on the Library's request for an increase of \$17,768 in allocation from the Town of Tuxedo in the operating budget. This is an increase of about \$4.66 per Tuxedo resident annually or a little over a penny per day.

The Library budget proposition will be on the back of the ballot and is worded:

SHALL THE ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION OF THE TOWN OF TUXEDO FOR THE OPERATING BUDGET OF THE TUXEDO PARK LIBRARY BE INCREASED BY SEVENTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT (\$17,768) DOLLARS TO THE SUM OF SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWO (\$600,602) DOLLARS ANNUALLY.
