Welcome to the 2020 Season!

Dear Members and Friends,

Thank you for your patience! We know that you have all been waiting for news about the beach club opening for this season and we are very happy to report that, despite many obstacles presented by the coronavirus pandemic, the club will be opening. The date will depend on scheduling our preseason inspection with the health department next week and as soon as that is complete we will send out the exact opening date and hours information. As with everything else in our lives since March, COVID-19 will affect beach operations and behaviors. However, the WWBC Executive Board decided that the extra effort and expense associated with complying to the mandatory state guidelines were outweighed by the need for our members to have a place to swim, relax and safely enjoy their summer. Protocols have been put in place which will be strictly enforced to protect both our members and employees, but we are confident that we can count on your cooperation for the good of all!

PLEASE NOTE - A FULL SET OF COVID-19 RULES IS ENCLOSED BUT WE WANT TO HIGHLIGHT THE FOLLOWING:

- We will have a COVID-19 monitor on duty to assist members in complying with the state guidelines. The monitor will do temperature and mask checks, direct cars to properly spaced parking spots, and help members demarcate their family area.
- Members are responsible for bringing their own masks to the beach and will not be allowed to enter without one for all household members. Children five and under are not required to wear a mask. Masks may be removed within your marked family area and when in the water.
- Social distancing must be observed at all times when outside of your family area.
- At the present time, as per the state guidelines, use of the picnic tables and grills is prohibited. This may change but until it does, please feel free to bring chairs and tables from home.

Traffic Safety

Each year we remind our members to drive slowly and carefully to the WWBC because we share the roads with many residents who are out jogging, cycling or just taking a stroll. This year, with many more residents occupying homes in the Village, it is even more critical that we do so. In cooperation with the Village of Tuxedo Park Board of Trustees and the Village Police Department we ask all members who are not Village residents to adhere to the following procedures:

- From Monday through Friday please access the beach via the main gate. Follow Tuxedo Road to Lorillard Road and then bear left onto Wee Wah Road to get to the beach. The Village has installed a license plate reader at the main gate and, like their residents, Wee Wah members will be asked to provide license plate info on our registration form.
- On Saturday and Sunday non-Village residents should access and exit the WWBC via the north gate. The north gate is located by driving through the Quarry Field parking lot off of Warwick Brook Road. A police officer will be stationed there to grant access. Once inside the gate, the WWBC is just a short distance away.
- As previously mentioned, we will be sharing the Village roads with many others. For the safety of all it is important that drivers follow a recommended speed limit of 20 mph. The Village police will be implementing several road safety and speed deterrents. Just as with masks and social distancing we must all do our part for the safety of others!

Donations

Donations are always gratefully accepted and allow us to continue to make improvements to the facility.

We would like to extend our thanks to the members who donated to the beach in 2019. Their contributions are greatly appreciated by all. There is a line on the registration form for anyone who would like to make a contribution. We can't thank everyone enough for their financial support.



Please note E-mail

The club's constitution allows us to send official notices via email. When filling out your registration form, please provide us with your current

email address. The use of email saves us money and provides the board with a timely and convenient way to notify members about issues of concern and upcoming events.

Please be assured that your address will be used only by the WWBC and not shared with any other organizations or businesses.

Swimming Hours

Due to liability concerns and Department of Health regulations, **no bathers may remain in the water past 8 pm or any other time there is insufficient visibility.**

Please note that swimming is not permitted while the lifeguard is setting up and storing our safety equipment. Also, all members and guests must leave the Beach Club premises when the lifeguard locks the gate. <u>NO ONE MAY REMAIN ON BEACH</u> <u>CLUB PROPERTY WITHOUT A LIFEGUARD ON</u> <u>DUTY.</u>

Please note: For safety reasons, the lifeguard on duty will take mandated breaks during the course of the day. **No one will be permitted in the water during the lifeguard's breaks!** We ask your cooperation in this important safety issue.

Carry In/Carry Out Trash Policy

Once again the WWBC will operate with a carry in/ carry out policy for trash. Please remember to bring a bag and take your trash with you as you leave. If you forget to bring a bag, simply request one from the checker.

Rules & Regulations

Please read all of the regular beach rules and the new COVID-19 compliance rules included with this letter.

Please note, all rules will be strictly enforced and failure to comply may result in the loss of membership (without a refund).

<u>Please remind your children and guests that the beach employees are the final authority at the Beach, and</u> <u>their directions must be followed at all times!</u>

If patrons continue to break beach rules, the Executive Committee will decide on one of the following two options:

- 1. Minor children must be accompanied to the beach by their parent, regardless of their age.
- 2. In the case of serious or continual infractions, the family's membership will be rescinded for the remainder of the season, and no refund will be given.

Check-in: Please wait patiently while the checker checks you in and ensures you have masks for ALL members of your party. DO NOT bypass the check-in line and park.

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

Due to COVID-19 our memberships have changed. We understand that your household may have expanded during the quarantine period and as a result of New York State on PAUSE. We have expanded memberships to include persons with whom you have been quarantined in the same household for at least the past 30 days; however, additional charges will apply.

***FULL FAMILY:** For parents, spouses, and dependent children under 22 years of age.

***SENIOR CITIZEN:** Available to those who have reached the age of 65. This is available to single members or couples who meet the age criteria only.

*YOUNG ADULT ADD-ON (purchased with FULL FAMILY or SENIOR CITIZEN memberships ONLY):

Adults aged 22-30 quarantining in the household for more than four consecutive weeks may be included for \$50 per person.

*ABOVE 30 ADULT ADD-ON (purchased with FULL FAMILY or SENIOR CITIZEN memberships

ONLY): Adults aged 30 and above quarantining in the household for more than four consecutive weeks may be included for \$65 per person.

SINGLE: For single adults with no dependent children.

FAMILY PASS FEES & POLICY

\$45 for 10 Family Passes \$65 for 20 Family Passes

Family Passes are kept at the checker's station at the beach, not mailed to members.

- 1. There will be a no GUEST policy this year, we have a limited exception for immediate family only.
- 2. Immediate family is defined as a parent, grandparent, child or grandchild of the member who is not otherwise eligible for membership and who has been actively practicing social distancing.
- 3. All Family Pass guests are subject to all rules, including COVID-19 rules.
- 4. Members MUST accompany Family Pass guests to the Beach, sign them in with the checker on duty and remain with their guests at all times. Any member who fails to do so risks the loss of Family Pass privileges.
- 5. Members must have Family Passes to bring any Family Pass guests, <u>no matter the age</u> of the guest.
- 6. Members must be at least 18 years old to sign in a Family Pass guest.
- 7. Children 12 and under do not count toward your total number of Family Pass guests, but they must be signed in with the checker.
- 8. Senior citizens DO count toward the total number of Family Pass guests.
- 9. Please familiarize yourself and your Family Pass guests with the WWBC rules as you are responsible for your family pass guests while they are at the Beach.

RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE WEE WAH BEACH CLUB

- 1. Swimming is prohibited after 8:00 PM or 30 minutes before sunset, whichever is earlier, and at any time a lifeguard is not on duty. No one is allowed on the premises when the gate is locked; the beach is then officially closed.
- 2. Non-swimmers may not be on the waterfront without the direct supervision of a parent, guardian or babysitter. Please check with a lifeguard regarding your child's swimming ability.
- 3. Children who have not completed 6th grade are not allowed at the beach facility unless they are supervised by a parent, guardian or babysitter. Babysitters must be at least 13 years old.
- 4. Children who have completed 6th grade may be at the beach without supervision provided they abide by all beach rules. Inappropriate or unsafe behavior will not be tolerated.
- 5. No swimming beyond the roped area.
- 6. Jumping off the dock or walls is prohibited.
- 7. Swimming under the raft or rough play on the raft is prohibited.
- 8. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
- 9. Tubes, rafts, inflatables, snorkels, fins, masks, balls and life preservers are not permitted in the water.
- 10. No glass containers allowed in the sand area or beachfront. Use picnic area for meals.
- 11. Animals are not allowed on the beach grounds at any time.
- 12. Ball playing is permitted on the grass area only, not in the sand.
- 13. No loud music shall be played.
- 14. Proper attire is to be worn at all times.
- 15. No boats, rafts etc. may be launched from or landed on beach property.
- 16. Everyone must take their trash with them when they leave.
- 17. No one under 21 is allowed to have alcoholic beverages at the beach.
- 18. Anyone destroying or defacing property will be held responsible for payment and may lose membership privileges.
- 19. Membership in the Beach Club does not include membership in the Wee Wah Fishing Club. Fishing is prohibited at the beach.
- 20. Wee Wah employees are the authority at the beach and their instructions are to be followed at all times.
- 21. The Executive Board may suspend anyone who violates the rules listed above. Membership fees will not be returned.

WEE WAH BEACH CLUB SUMMER 2020 COVID-19 RULES

In order to be permitted to open the Wee Wah this summer, WWBC must comply will rules set forth by NY State and the Village of Tuxedo Park. The WWBC has agreed to abide by these rules in order to be permitted to open the WWBC to members amidst this pandemic. We take the safety of our members and our commitment to follow and enforce these rules very seriously and we ask for your cooperation. We understand that they are stringent but we believe that offering a place for people to swim and visit (at a distance) with community members outweighs the inconvenience.

- 1. <u>Social Distancing</u>: Any non-related or non-household members must maintain a 6 foot distance from other members (children included) at all times (including in the water).
- 2. <u>No Guests:</u> There will be no guests permitted, except for immediate family guest passes, see 4, below.
- 3. <u>No Parties:</u> There will be no parties permitted at WWBC this summer.
- 4. <u>Family Passes:</u> Family passes will be permitted but only for immediate family of the member (i.e. parents, grandparents, children, and grandchildren). Siblings, cousins, aunts, and uncles will not be considered immediate family.
- 5. <u>Masks</u>: No one above the age of five will be permitted to enter the WWBC without a mask. Masks must be worn unless you are (1) in the water or (2) in your allocated socially distanced membership space.
- 6. <u>Health Checks:</u> All members will be asked if they have been experiencing any COVID related symptoms. Any member who has been exposed to someone who has tested positive OR is experiencing symptoms should not use the WWBC unless and until they have been symptom free for 10 days. **WE ARE ALL RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR COMMUNITY.**
- 7. <u>Temperature Checks</u>: WWBC will be employing temperature checks as a condition to entry.
- 8. <u>Cars:</u> Cars must be parked with sufficient space on either side to allow for social distancing. Parking spots will be either (1) marked or (2) you will be directed to a spot by the COVID 19 monitor or checker.
- 9. <u>Assigned Areas:</u> All member units will select a spot at WWBC each time they enter, all spots will be at least 6 10 feet apart from other assigned spots. The COVID-19 monitor or checker will demarcate the assigned area. Members may take off masks in allocated spots. When outside the allocated spaces, masks must be worn and social distancing between non household members of at least 6 feet must be observed.
- 10.<u>Bathrooms</u>: Only one household membership at a time may use the restrooms. Members must inform the COVID-19 monitor or checker after use to ensure that bathrooms are cleaned in accordance with State Guidelines.
- 11.<u>Playground and Recreation Equipment:</u> Will not be available initially.
- 12.<u>Picnic Tables and Grills:</u> According to State Guidelines, picnic tables and grills will not be available for use, initially. We will inform members if these guidelines change. Members

are welcome to bring portable tables and chairs for their own use. Spaces will be available in the picnic area for members to use as their designated spaces.

- 13.<u>One-way Traffic:</u> Pedestrian traffic will be one way and in a counter clockwise direction. The first set of stairs will be used to enter the water and the stairs closest to the lifeguard will be used to exit the water.
- 14.<u>Supervising Children:</u> Children under 11 must be directly supervised by parents at all times, parents are responsible for children social distancing.
- 15.<u>Raft:</u> Raft use will be regulated by the lifeguard. All raft use to be pre approved by lifeguard on duty to allow for proper social distancing.
- 16.<u>COVID 19 Monitor</u>: The WWBC will employ a COVID 19 monitor to enforce the NY State Guidelines, WWBC rules and answer questions. Failure to comply with requests of the COVID 19 monitor may result in your being asked to leave the WWBC.
- 17.<u>Traffic:</u> When driving in Tuxedo Park all members are expected to drive below the posted speed limit or or posted recommendations. Speed limits will be strictly enforced by the Village with no exceptions. Please be cautious and courteous; pedestrian and pet traffic is heavier than in prior years.

- 19.<u>Hot Spot Quarantining:</u> No one may enter the WWBC if they have recently traveled to a NY Hotspot and have not completed the 14-day self-quarantine.

NON VILLAGE MEMBER ACCESS

- 1. <u>Weekdays:</u> Non-Village members and their guests will use the main gate Monday through Friday. Once in the Village, please follow the preferred route map.
- 2. <u>Weekend Access North Gate:</u> Non-Village members and their guests entering Tuxedo Park on Saturday and Sunday MUST use the north gate. The north gate can be accessed through Quarry Field. All non-Village members will provide license plate information with their membership application. The Village reserves the right to request identification from anyone entering through the north gate. *THE NORTH GATE MUST BE USED ON WEEKENDS UNLESS WE COMMUNICATE OTHERWISE*.

<u>Please note, all rules will be strictly enforced and failure to comply may result in loss of</u> <u>membership. WWBC reserves the right to modify the rules at any time upon verbal or</u> <u>written notice.</u>
