

MAYOR'S MONTHLY MESSAGE-July 2026

Dear Neighbors,

The Board of Trustees has passed bond resolutions with respect to three necessary infrastructure projects. Two projects, the West Lake Road Bridge/Culvert and the Pond #3 Dam and roadway have been completed. The bond resolutions are for 20 year financing in the amounts of \$225K and \$400K respectively. The funds received from the issuance of those bonds will be used to reimburse the General & Reserve Funds that were used to pay for the completed projects. The third project is for the NYS DEC mandated future Village sewer improvements in the amount of \$900K. The term for that financing is 40 years.

At the upcoming August 20 meeting, the Board of Trustees will consider a proposed Local Law to prohibit the rental of accessory structures, such as boathouses, barns, garages, pools and tennis courts to the general public. A Public Hearing will be held prior to any vote on adoption of the proposed Local Law.

As the Wee Wah Beach Club nears completion of another successful season, the Board of Trustees will begin discussion of opening the Beach to all Village residents next summer and incorporating the operating costs into the Village budget. Town residents would continue to pay membership fees.

The Village is seeking a grant from NYS to fund a feasibility study for installation of an oxygenation system in Tuxedo Lake which would diminish a rising anoxic water layer in the warm weather.

The Board of Trustees has approved an agreement with New England Aquatic for the service of divers to remove, by hand, areas of milfoil in the lakes.

With the assistance of a Village resident with years of IT experience, the Village will soon launch a new website. Stay tuned for the announcement.

The culprit who damaged the posted signage at the South Gate last week has been identified by the TTPD through use of cameras as a box truck from New Jersey that was attempting a U-turn after being denied entrance. An insurance claim has been made.

The Village is seeking residents to volunteer to serve the community on the Board of Architecture Review; the Wee Wah Park Committee and the Welcome Committee. If you are interested in joining the BAR or either of the Committees, please contact me.
